

Music, Dance, and Art:

Music through singing, rhythm, instruments, movement and dance will be a part of our everyday curriculum. The use of music and instruments promote higher learning skills. Brain development research supports this finding. Students that are engaged in music, vocal, instrumental, etc. have a larger capacity for math than those that do not. The findings show an actual difference in the size of the brain in those areas affected.

Dance and creative movement activities will be taught to promote coordination, grace, perception, and language development. Art - In the form of water colors, drawing, pottery, arts and crafts. Our curriculum will reflect the expressive facets of our children's personalities, their surroundings, both kinesthetically, and visually, as they express their inner feelings through their hands and thoughts with different media.
