Our Artist for November is Henry Matisse 1864 -1954



Henry Matisse decided to make his artwork using paper cutouts. It may look simple but it is not as easy as it looks. Matisse observed his subject for a long time and studied it very closely. He made drawings, and might even work for an entire week before he picked up a pair of scissors. Henry Matisse made his own colored paper,



by painting white sheets of paper with paints he mixed himself. When he had the perfect color he started thinking like a sculptor and cut away his materials rather than adding them. He created simple forms filled with energy. You could say he drew with "scissors." He wanted his art to make you feel what the subject of his paper felt. He said: "There's no greatness in making eyes, a nose or mouth. Accuracy is not truth." The different colors and shapes make us feel different emotions.
